1 John 4:13-21

1. How, according to verses 13-16, do we know that we live in him and he in us?
 - a. A mental assurance of grace affirmed in scripture.
 - b. The presence of His Spirit in our lives.
 - c. The testimony and affirmation of Jesus as the Son of God.
 - d. Love...and remember what that really means (4:10)!

2. How do we know that we have been given the Spirit?
 - a. We guess about it or hope for it, since we know that it is mentioned in the scripture.
 - b. Gifts of the Spirit (Rom 12:6-8, 1 Cor 12:8-10).
 - c. The Fruit of the Spirit (Gal 5:22-23).
 - d. The witness of his Spirit (Rom 8:14-17).

3. How, according to 4:17-18, can we have confidence on the day of judgment?
 - a. Love is made complete among us.
 - b. In this world we are like Jesus.
 - c. His perfect love has driven out our fear.
 - d. We are no longer afraid of punishment because his love fills us.
 - e. His perfect love has so filled us that we display it constantly by obeying his commands, remaining in him, loving others, and just overflowing with true love in action as it says in 3:18.
