a b c	 What happened to Jehoahaz and Judah in verse 23:33-35? Pharaoh Necho put him in chains so that he might not reign. Pharaoh Necho imposed a levy of a hundred talents of silver and a talent of gold. Pharaoh Necho made Eliakim son of Josiah king in place of his father Josiah and changed Eliakim's name to Jehoiakim. Pharaoh Necho took Jehoahaz and carried him off to Egypt, and there he died. Johoiakim paid Pharaoh Necho the silver and gold he demanded, but taxed the people order to do so.
V	What sort of king was Jehoiakim?
a b	What happened to Judah in 24:1? Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon invaded the land. Jehoiakim became Nebuchadnezzar's vassal. Jehoiakim turned against Nebuchadnezzar and rebelled.
a b	What happened in 24:2? It was an attack of the enemy. It was the fulfillment of prophesy. It was the hand of God.
a	Why do bad things happen in your life? Bad things happen to good people. Even Jesus suffered on the cross! The hand of God may be against me because of my sin and the sin I've caused others commit.
