  - b. Mary poured perfume on him and wiped his feet with her hair. They must have really loved him.
  - c. It says that Jesus loved Lazarus and this whole family.
5. What happened to Lazarus before Jesus got there, according to verse 11-13?
  - a. He was tired and fell asleep.
  - b. Lazarus died.
6. Why did Jesus let Lazarus die when he could have come earlier?
  - a. He didn’t really care about this family.
  - b. He didn’t need to panic as we often do because he knew how the story would end.
  - c. By this, God’s Son would be glorified (verse 4).
  - d. So that his disciples would believe (verses 14-15).
7. What was going on when Jesus arrived, according to verses 17-19?
  - a. Lazarus had just died.
  - b. Lazarus had been dead for four days already and Jesus arrived during the funeral.
  - c. Lazarus was already buried.
  - d. Many people from Jerusalem, which was nearby, had come to see the family.
8. What did Mary and Martha do when Jesus arrived, according to verses 20-32?
  - a. Martha went out to meet Jesus.
  - b. Mary stayed home.
  - c. Martha told Jesus that she knew he could have healed Lazarus if he had just been there.
  - d. Mary eventually came out too, but she also told Jesus that she knew he could have healed
