## A.L.I.V.E. Bible Study Date: November 12, 2017 Hebrews 13:7-10

- 1. What instructions did the writer of Hebrews give us in last week's study?
  - a. Keep on loving one another, show hospitality to strangers, and remember those who are mistreated and suffering.
  - b. Marriage should be honored and the marriage bed kept pure because God will judge the adulterous or sexually immoral.
  - c. Our lives should be free from the love of money, we should be content, and we should trust God as our helper who does not leave us nor forsake us.
- 2. What do verses 7-8 tell us?
  - a. Remember your leaders, who spoke the word of God to you.
  - b. Consider the outcome of their way of life.
  - c. Imitate their faith.
  - d. Jesus is the same yesterday and today and forever.
  - e. He seems to be reminding us (as chapter 11 did) that those who have gone before us should serve as witnesses to the power of God and his care for us.
- 3. How do you think about your leaders?
  - a. Who are they and what gave them the right?
  - b. Well, I owe a lot to them because of how God has used them in my life!
  - c. It is good to have those who go before us to show us the way, so I watch them and listen to them as God uses them to grow me.
  - d. I'm careful because I am suspicious of leaders when so many are selfish and dishonest.
  - e. Other.
- 4. What do verses 9-10 tell us?
  - a. Do not be carried away by all kinds of strange teachings.
  - b. It is good for our hearts to be strengthened by grace, not by eating ceremonial foods...
  - c. We have an altar from which those who minister at the tabernacle have no right to eat.

5.	What does it mean for our hearts to be strengthened by grace?

- 6. What is he trying to say about the altar?
  - a. People thought that the meat that was sacrificed was special and brought something special to those who were permitted to eat it (Deut 18:1-8, Lev 6:24-29).
  - b. Don't feel less special because you are not offering sacrifices any more, our offering and the blessing we receive from it is even holier than the old testament sacrifice.
  - c. Jesus is better.
