W	hat day was it, when Jesus died, according to verse 15:42?
	hy is this significant?
w.a.b.c.d.	hat do we learn about Joseph of Arimathea in verses 15:43-47? He was a prominent member of the Council. He was, himself, waiting for the kingdom of God. He went boldly to Pilate and asked for Jesus' body and Pilate gave it to him. He bought some linen cloth, took down the body, wrapped it in the linen, and placed it in a tomb cut out of rock. He rolled a stone against the entrance of the tomb and two Mary's saw where he was laid.
a.b.c.d.	when the Sabbath was over, two Mary's bought spices so that they might anoint Jesus' body. Very early on the first day of the week, just after sunrise, they were on their way to the tomb and they asked each other, "Who will roll the stone away from the entrance of the tomb?" When they looked up, they saw that the stone had been rolled away. As they entered the tomb, they saw a young man dressed in a white robe sitting on the right side and they were alarmed. The young man told them not to be alarmed and declares that Jesus is risen. They are told to go tell his disciples and Peter, "He is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him, just as he told you." Trembling and bewildered, the women went out and fled the tomb, but said nothing to anyone because they were afraid.
