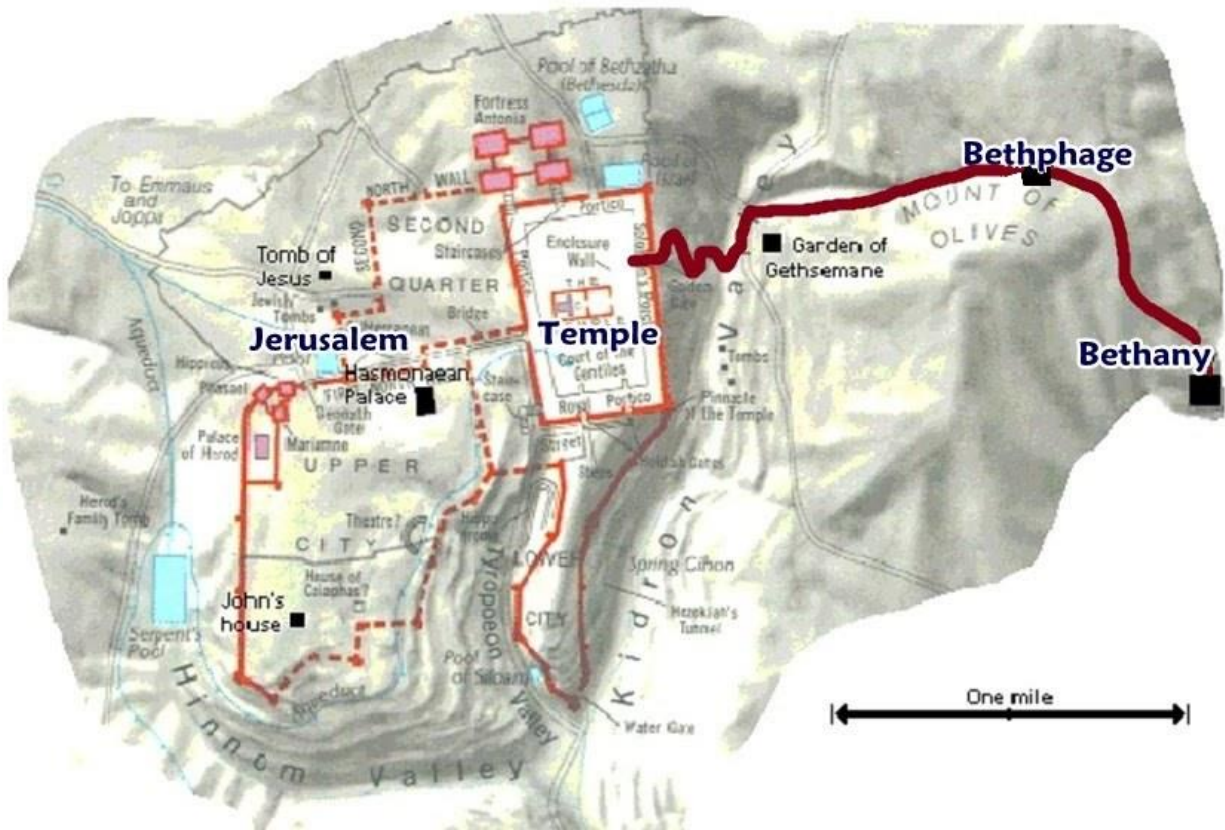


**A.L.I.V.E. Bible Study**
